Re: Government Lockdown Announcement

Following the government's announcement last night about the increased measures put in place from today, to help control the spread of COVID. The new lockdown rules include the closure of schools, colleges and universities. I want to reassure all parents, the Early Years sector has been given the green light to stay open.

Scientists have recognised, young children are at very low risk of catching or spreading the virus. Consequently, it is far more beneficial for them to remain in their nursery setting, continue with their routines in learning and development, as well as being able to play and socialise with their peers, to provide some sense of normality.
