CURRICULUM ACTIVITIES: Our learning topic this month is 'Animal Kingdom'. Each care room will be doing age appropriate activities for their children, to teach them about the other animals we share our planet with. Following the seven areas of the EYFS, we're looking at our pets at home, to animals in the farmyard or the darkest jungle, what lives in the sea or on the plains of Africa. Discovering where they live, the sounds they make, their size and the colour and textures of their skin. The children have already seen the chicken eggs hatch and returned to their farm home and caterpillars develop in to beautiful butterflies, which they loved releasing in the garden.

Support at Home:- Get the whole family having fun with this topic, looking at books together, animals in the field. Or plan a visit to a pet shop, venture to a petting farm or even a zoo. Talk to your little one's about the animals you see. Where does it live? What sound do they make? How many legs? What does it eat? Learning should be fun! We will post our curriculum planning on our private Facebook page, providing information and ideas about how you can support your child's nursery education at home, or just ask a staff member.

PARENTS EVENING: We will be contacting parents shortly, in readiness to organise 1:1 meetings or phone conversations, with your child's key worker, to have a dedicated conversation about your child's early years development and their record of achievement file, to have a look at, go through and talk about their next steps. Working together, we can ensure all our little ones are well prepared for their future education at big school. We will be giving out more information over the coming weeks, to arrange a mutually convenient appointment time.

CELEBRATIONS:- We're already preparing for the Queen's Platinum Jubilee celebration! Making crowns, Union Jacks and talking about what this amazing 70 year achievement means in our country's history and as part of our culture and heritage. We hope to create a lasting memory of an event, which will never happen again in our lifetimes. As part of our celebrations, every child on our current registers, will receive their own special Jubilee commemorative 50p from the royal mint as part of their memory with ABC and the occasion.

We'll also be getting creative for all our lovely dads, making cards with love for Father's Day on Sunday, 19th June.

GOING TO FULL-TIME SCHOOL:- Foundation Stage staff have already started the process of children's transition to BIG school, liaising with and inviting their new teacher to come and meet your child here at nursery. We also provide schools with their record of attainment through the Foundation Stage curriculum, so they can carry on their progress working towards KS1.

All our over 3's Pre-School children will automatically transfer to our Foundation Stage class in September. If children are leaving us, WE NEED FOUR WEEKS NOTICE IN WRITING, to be able to transfer the funding to school. Please note: a child in a school Foundation Stage class is NOT guaranteed a full-time place at that school. An application must be made online to Kirklees admissions and will be allocated a full-time school in line with the LEA criteria.
